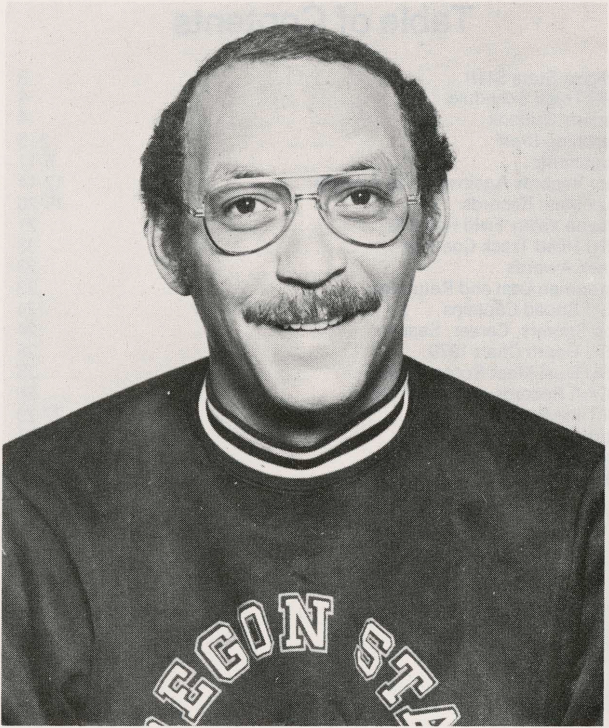

Originally from St. Mary's High in Medford. Attended OSU for two and a half years before going to Saudi Arabia with Coach Berny Wagner in December of 1975. Returned to USA in 1977 and enrolled at Southern Oregon College. While there, he won the NAIA 3000 meter steeplechase, also the NAIA cross-country championship.

STEVE DeAUTREMONT — Graduate Assistant

A 1970 graduate of OSU, Steve was twice the top hammer thrower in the nation, both in NCAA and AAU. He has been a valuable assistant with training procedures and the weight program. In fact, he set up the weight program for the football team.

ED LIPSCOMB — Graduate Assistant

Has served as a part time coach and has been a big help to the pole vaulters. Ed was NCAA champion vaulter in 1974, and holds the all time Oregon State University best mark of 17-4½.

HEAD TRACK COACH

Steve Simmons

Now in his fourth season as Head Track and Field Coach at Oregon State University is personable Steve Simmons, who is well-known at the international level.

Simmons came to OSU from Cal Poly in San Luis Obispo, where he compiled an outstanding record for five years. He didn't begin his career in the state of California. He attended Roosevelt High School in Dayton, Ohio, and later moved west to Los Angeles City College where he graduated in June of 1963. He was at Chapman College (Cal.) in Orange from 1963-65 and gained another degree in 1965. He was an all-city basketball player at L.A. City College and was a 1965 NCAA Division II All-American high hurdler at Chapman.

Simmons has served as a triple jump coach at three U.S. Olympic specialized training camps, in 1971, 1975 and 1976. He has served as a visiting coach and conducted clinics in Brazil, Kenya, the Ivory Coast, Denmark, Nigeria and many other faraway places.

Simmons has been extremely active in international track. He was an assistant on the first U.S. World Cup team. Also came a selection to the Amateur Athletic Union's international committee. Steve also coached the U.S. 400 meter relay team that set a new world record at the World Cup meet.

Simmons' coaching record at Cal Poly from 1970 through 1975 was superb. He coached 40 NCAA All-Americans and five national champions. He coached athletes who set or tied 52 indoor and outdoor records. Some of his "name" performers included Reynaldo Brown, Curtis Boyd, Clancy Edwards, Ken Haagen, Dave Hamer, Mohinder Gill and Curtis Byrd.

As one of America's top jump coaches, in seven years watched men he coached score 97½ points in jumping events in NCAA competition. A man of many dimensions, Steve coached NCAA Division I and II All-Americans in 11 different events.

Simmons' most recent honor was election to the staff of the 1980 U.S. Olympic team as assistant manager. Among duties there will be team trials and management, assemble equipment, team liason and transportation for the games in Moscow. This appointment is probably the most important one that Steve has won.

Simmons has received certificates of commendation for his coaching efforts from the governments of Kenya, Nigeria, Brazil and the United States.

Simmons has launched a recruiting program that he hopes will take OSU to the top half of the Pac-10. The 1978 squad began to show some success and development when it became plagued with injuries. Steve is hopeful the 1979 Beavers can avoid those injuries in 1979.

The recruiting and coaching program launched by Steve since his arrival at OSU began to show promise in 1978 when the Beavers had their finest season in 3 years and hosted an outstanding Pac-8 meet in Corvallis.

Thumbnail Sketches

KASHEEF HASSAN: 5-9, 142, sophomore from Khartown, Sudan. Returns for second season at OSU, with tremendous season behind him. Started off with a 46.4 in the 400 against Arizona and ended with a 45.23 and 20.77 winning efforts in the African championships. He was ranked 9th in the world in the 400 meters by Track and Field News. He was third in the Pac-8 400 and anchored the OSU third place 1600 meter relay team. At Ali Indoor meet this past winter, he ran his first indoor meet in world record time of 46.6, but was disqualified. Two weeks later, he won the 600 at the Sunkist Meet in 1:10.1. Hassan's winter training has been built around the 800 and he will participate in both the 400 and 800 this spring. Kasheef was a member of the 1976 Olympic team from Sudan.

SCOTT FISHER: 5-10, 165, senior from Medford, Ore. Injuries have plagued Fisher, a fine competitor. He was the Pacific-8 pole vault champion in 1976, but since has suffered through past two seasons with injuries. If he can stay healthy, Scott might approach or surpass his all-time best mark of 17- $\frac{1}{4}$. In fact, he might even be a candidate for national honors. He is a former state high school champion from Medford High and also is the OSU freshman record holder at 16-6.

RICK KUMM: 6-2, 155, junior from Sprague High of Salem. Top returning miler for the Beavers. Will be running the full range of middle distances this spring. Has underclass credentials of 3:45.2 and 1:50.5. Still can be one of best 1500 meter men in the Pacific-10 conference. Outstanding record as a prepper and won the 800 and mile races at state prep meet.

DAN FULTON: 5-9, 140, senior from Benson Tech of Portland. Was a 1978 co-captain, but suffered through injuries most of season and was able to compete in only five meets. With full health, could be top distance runner for the Beavers. He has bests of 4:05.8, 13:43 and 9.09 for 3000 steeplechase. Great leader and hard worker. State prep champion, also had a year at Spokane Community College.

ANDREW FIELDS: 5-9, 155, junior from Grant High in Sacramento. "Drew" is considered by Coach Simmons as a top prospect for conference honors this spring. Last year ran a 51.46 and was fifth at the Pac-8 meet at 51.59. Was leadoff runner on OSU's third place relay team at Pac-8 that had time of 3:07.9. At indoor meet this past winter in Seattle, he set a new school record for the indoor 440 at 49.0. Had fine fall in training, has great competitive drive. Picked by teammates as most improved track man, along with Joel Johnson.

DWAYNE HALL: 6-2, 185, senior from Dorsey High of Los Angeles. Returns to the track scene after a year's absence. Dwayne is valuable split end on the OSU football team. Has run 9.7 and 21.5 and Coach Simmons feels he could break under 21.0 in the 200. A fluid runner with good strength, Hall will run both sprints and on the 400 meter relay. In football, was No. 2 pass receiver on squad. Caught 25 passes for 408 yards and three touchdowns.

MARK WHITE: 6-1, 150, freshman from Richmond, Cal. Comes to OSU as first signee and one of the most versatile athletes to enroll in some time. Has best high school marks of 14.0, 53.53, 48.8 and 1:55.6. He will run both hurdle races and the relay and probably will challenge several freshman records. Mark's twin brother, Mike, was the 4th ranked high school half-miler in the nation in 1978, and is enrolled at Cal-Berkeley. A younger brother is the top sprinter among northern California high schools.

MARK MELAHN: 5-10, 150, freshman from Klamath Falls. Versatile-type athlete, has been impressive since coming to OSU in the fall. He was OSU's first finisher in the conference cross-country meet. As prepper, he was third in 3000 meter race and 4th in the 1500. At OSU, will be busy man, running the 1500, 5000 and 3000 steeplechase. Coach Simmons says he has fine potential.

BRUCE ALEXANDER: 6-3, 200, senior from Clackamas High of Milwaukie. Is coming off an injury-redshirt year, and if healthy will be one of the better javelin throwers in the conference. He is a dedicated trainer and could win points for the Beavers. His best mark was a 224-3 toss against San Jose State two years ago.

TOM SCHILLINGER: 6-0, 255, junior from Burns. Was elected most valuable athlete on track squad, and was mainstay on Beaver football squad as well. Competed in the discus, shotput and hammer throw and led team in points scored. His discus toss of 181-8 placed him a close third in the Pac-8 championships. One of Oregon's best all-around athletes. In senior year, was state discus champion, state heavyweight wrestling champion and first team all-state in football.

YAIR KARNI: 5-9, 145, sophomore from Israel. Yair is Israeli record holder in five events, from the 800 through 3000 steeplechase. Could be the surprise of the OSU team this spring. He'll be competitive in the 1500, 3000 steeplechase, 5000 and the 10,000. His all-time best mile time was 4:06.6 and the 1500 3:49.1. Coach Simmons feels his best event may be the steeplechase.

TIM FOX: 6-0, 235, junior from Bend. Was off to a great 1978 start, but injured his knee two days after his first meet. In his one and only competition of 1978, he threw the discus 188-11, the hammer 172-0 and the shotput 47-0. All these marks were personal records. After his injury-redshirt year, he's anxious to be back on the trail and is looking forward to competing against Pac-10 and NCAA competition.

GREG TAFRALIS: 6-0, 245, junior from Millbrae, Cal. A junior college transfer from Skyline JC in San Bruno, Greg had marks of 55-7¾ and 181-6 last year to rank as the top JC weight "doubler" and prepare himself for the tough Pac-10 competition. He enjoys training with the other two weights men — Tim Fox and Tom Schillinger. Greg should hit the 60-0 shot mark and 190 discus.

MARK FRICKER: 5-11, 154, freshman from Hemet, Cal. Probably the most versatile new athlete OSU has. His best marks are 1:52.5 in 880; 4:07.9 in mile; 3:47.6 in 1500; and 49.4 in 440. Is strong runner who has profited by a good session of fall workouts. He has appeared in many post-season meets against all-star competition. Is a student in the school of Agriculture. Was active and successful in cross-country running, as well as regular track.

CHESTER PEEPLE: 6-1½, 175, freshman from Roseburg High School. Was runner-up in Oregon state meet in the 400 and brought his mile relay team from behind to finish first. At OSU, Chester probably will compete in the 200, 400 and high jump. His prep best marks were 22.2, 48.2, and 6-6. Coach Simmons feels that he could become one of Oregon State's best ever quartermilers. "He has the full potential," Coach Simmons says.

MICHAEL WASHINGTON: 6-2, 185, freshman from Burbank High School in Sacramento. A strong fluid runner, Michael could be one of the better sprinters in the conference. His best marks include 9.66 and 21.45, plus a 50.5 in the 440. A fine, three-sport athlete who also played baseball and football. Washington also ran on relay teams on occasion.

JOEL JOHNSON: 6-2, 175, senior from Junction City. Along with Andrew Fields, was selected as "most improved" athlete of last year. A decathlon expert, he came to OSU as the national junior college champion (6825 points) from Lane CC in Eugene. At OSU, he improved his total mark to 7414, but also placed in the Pac-8 championships. He then went on to finish 11th at the NCAA meet, scoring 7353. Joel's best decathlon mark is 7414.
