Festivals.

1st grade festivals

- Feb. 25-- Kinen sai , festival prayers for good harvest.
Nov, 23-- Nii name sai, or 1st tasting festival at all Shinto shrines.
Aug. 15-- Rei sai.

Shi sai or Private Festivals.

- Jan. 7-- Nana kusa matsuri, (nana=7, kusa=kind) 7 different kinds of vegetables are mixed in a gruel made of rice, and red beans to celebrate the 7th day of the 1st month. *A Kind of Dance is performed by Hayato on this day.*
Feb. 18-- Hatsu-u-matsuri or "1st day of the Hare" fest.
April 10-- Fuji matsuri (Fuji=wisteria), *so called because many wisteria flowers are offered.*
June 5-- Mita uye sai or Rice transplanting festival.

~~Oct.~~ 15-- Hama goten miyuki matsuri, (hama=beach, go=august, ten or den=mansion, miyuki=journey) or journey of the Deities to the shrine on the beach. *The procession is very magnificent!*
