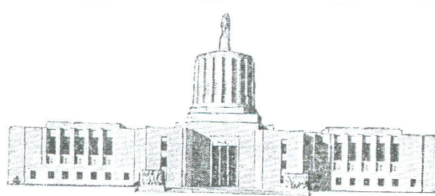
Today rec'd your letter & we do have old letters, pict, deed, maps etc.
