This indenture made this the 6th day of October 1890 at Lane County State of Oregon, by and between James M. Martin as administrator of the Estate of Mary Ann Martin deceased, party of the first part, and Jesse G. Drummer party of the second part; witnesses that whereas by an order of the County Court of said Lane County State of Oregon, made at the June Term thereof of 1890 which order was duly entered on the 3rd day of June in Volume Four of the Probate Records of said County on page 447 authorizing said administrator to sell the real property herein after described, and whereas on the 7th day of July 1890 said administrator sold the following described Real Property to the said party of the second part at Public auction he being the highest and best bidder therefor, to wit: Commencing at the South East corner of the Donation Land claim of Martin, P. Martin and wife, Notification No 862 claim N 41 being part of section Eight in Township No Twenty one South Range Three West; thence North 20.23 1/2 chains; thence West 39.56 1/2 chains; thence South 20.23 1/2 chains thence East 24.56 1/2 chains to the place of beginning, containing 80 acres of land for the sum of \$1100.00 which sale was duly confirmed at the July Term of said Court on the 11th day of July 1890, and which order of Confirmation, duly entered in Volume Four of the Probate Records of said County on page 449 and whereas on the 17th day of Sept 1890 said administrator sold at Public auction at the Court House door of said County the following described Real Property to said party of the second part he being the highest bidder therefor to wit: Commencing 39.56 1/2 chains West of the South East Corner of said Donation Land claim of Martin, P. Martin and wife on the South line thereof; thence North 20.23 1/2 chains; thence West

19.71 chains; thence South 110.47 chains; thence East 14.78 chains
to the place of beginning. Containing 80 ac in said section 8 in said Township
21 S.R. & N. for the sum of \$575.00 which order of sale was duly confirmed on
the 6th day of October 1890 and duly entered in Volume Four of the Probate
Records of said County on page 671. Now therefore in consideration of the
promises and the said sum of money being paid the receipt of which I
hereby acknowledged, I hereby and by these presents do bargain sell and
convey to the said Jesse H. Drummell all the interest which the said Mary
Ann Martin had in the aforesaid described property at the time of
her death - To have and to hold unto the said Jesse H. Drummell, his
heirs and assigns forever.
