I, Harvey Lee Jackson & my wife Flora Jackson of Route 3, Box 303, Molalla, Oregon, are owners of 160 acres of the Donation land claim taken out by my Grandparents, Andrew and Mary Jackson in 1852, located $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Marquam, Oregon, in Clackamas County. Our 160 acres is the north half of the tract of land which was my Grandmother, Mary Jackson's part.

Our farm clears more than \$300.00 a year.

Our farm has been owned and farmed by our family for 106 years. My father Clarence Frank Jackson, who will be 96 years old Aug. 3, was born and raised on our farm and is still living. His mind is clear, and he is quite active. He bought the land from his mother, Mary Jackson, and we in turn bought the land from my father, Clarence Frank Jackson. The first of Jan. of this year, we leased the farm to our son, Kenneth Lloyd Jackson, but we are still living on the farm.

The description of the land is as follows,

- Parcel 1: The northeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 34, T.5.S.R.I.E. of the W.M., Clackamas County, Oregon, containing 80.00 acres of land, save and except 1.80 acres of land more or less that has been deeded for road purposes (Book 289, page 279)
- Parcel 2: The northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the north half of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 27, T.5. S.R.I.E. of the W.M., in Clackamas County, Oregon, containing 30 acres more or less. (Book 187 page 496)
- Parcel 3: The west half of the southeast quarter of ~~the~~ southwest quarter of section 27, T.5.S.R.I.E. of the W.M., in Clackamas County, State of Oregon, containing 20 acres of land be the same more or less. (Book 148 page 342)
- Parcel 4: The south half of the southwest quarter in t he southeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter in the southwest quarter, all being in section 27, T.5.S.R.I.E. Of the W.M., in Clackamas County, Oregon, and containing 30 acres of land more or less. (Book 249 page 131)

We have the original Donation Land Claim Deed. And my father Clarence Frank Jackson, 333 Brown Street, Woodburn, Oregon, has the Engle Clan Book published I think in 1938, which gives dates and tells of crossing the plains and so forth. My Grandmothers Mary Jackson's maiden name was Engle.
