ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Giles Daugherty purchased this 320 acre farm from Robert Hull on June 9, 1864 for the sum of Five Hundred dollars.

Giles Daugherty and Sally (Doked) Daugherty were natives of Virginia, moving to Pike County Illinois where he was a blacksmith and farmer.

In 1852 he crossed the plains with nine children. His wife died on the trip, and he later remarried twice.

He settled on a donation land claim in Polk County, living there a few years eventually moved to a farm near Hubbard, then moving to this farm at Molalla.

His son Charley was next to farm the land. He married Mary Sawtell and they had five sons. Fred the youngest took over the farm after his father's death.

At present the farm consists of 187 acres owned and operated by a Great Grandson, Charles Daugherty.

A great deal of grain, seeds, and all kinds of livestock have been raised on this farm. At present the pastures are sown to grass. Sheep and Beef are raised as well as some Dairy Cattle.

This Indenture; made and entered into this the ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four between Robert Hull of the first part and Giles Daugherty, of the second part. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars, lawful money of the United States the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has this day sold, and by these presents do, sell, bargain and convey unto the party of the second part, the following described tract of land, or ground situate, lying and being in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, known and described as follows to wit, being the West half of the East half of Section twenty seven Township five South, Range two East, also the East half of the West half of section twenty seven Township five South, Range two East, containing three hundred and twenty acres the same more or less, unto the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. The party of the first part doth agree to forever warrant and defend the title hereof unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written.
