a.m. <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</u> grandfater Shibley bought the homestead in 1878 and he and my father both took homesteads adjoining the property. My father Ja. Shibley married mary marrs daughter of Lafayette Mans so I have both grandfather and fathers homes teads. Father and mother lived on the place 62 years and I am youngest son, being born here in 1898 and have never lived anywhere else. Both familys crossed plains with OX. teams, mother in 61 from Arbansas and father from Missouri in 63. In conjunction with county agent this was the first Place to hold a lime demonstration. We raised the first grass seed in district and in 1952 I was grass man of year. Then went on to be Cattleman of the year in State of Oregon m. 1953.
