ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

It could very well be possible that Washington P. Hermann was living on the land before 1843 as his father Dr. Henry Hermann, Homesteaded right across the river in 1859, and Grandfather Hermann was pretty well grown then.

After Grandfather's death, Grandmother divided the Place. Dad got 42.43 acres and his 2 sisters each got 32 acres. Grandmother keeping the balance, which she later sold to E. L. Clausen. The 32 acre Places were later sold also. After my father Arthur B. Hermann passed away in 1958, I bought my sisters interest in the Place which leaves me the sole owner.

I was born on the Place, and have lived on it all my life 58 in September.

The land was all Myrtle & Maple timber then. In a big River Bottom. & all had to be cleared up.
