ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Mr. and Mrs. Champion T. Payne came to the Willamette Valley in Oregon in the fall of 1852 from Sheridan County, Missouri. They came to Jackson County and settled in the Fern Valley area in the 1860's. They owned approximately 1000 acres at one time. The particular piece of land, that our farm is a part of, was bought by Mr. C. T. Payne in May, 1869. Payne Creek (which runs through our property), Payne Road and Paynea Cliffs (in this area) all received their name from Mr. Payne.

Miss Amanda Lee Payne, the 2nd youngest Payne child, married George Alford, January 1, 1902. They bought about 120 Acres from Mr. and Mrs. Champion T. Payne in March, 1902.

One daughter, Ethel Alford married Lester Carr and had three children, George, Robert and David. Mrs. Ethel Carr and her sister Echo Alford each inherited half of the Alford farm.

In 1955, I (Robert Carr) bought my Aunt (Mrs. Echo Alford Shutt's) share of the farm and I still farm it with my wife Karen and three children Dale, Darrell and Cynthia.
