

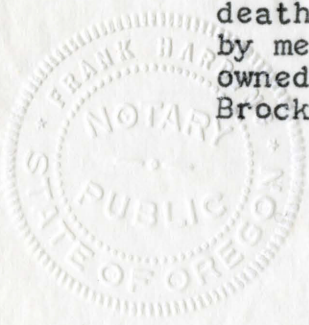

I, Tempa Jean Brock, being first duly sworn, depose and say:

That I am unmarried and have never been married; that I am a granddaughter of Vineyard C. Brock and am living on the 40 acres of his original D.L.C. filed for in 1854 and patented in 1865, located in Township 13 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Linn County, Oregon; that I own 40 acres of said D.L.C.; that the same was owned and occupied by my grandfather until his death and by my father, Steward P. Brock from the death of my grandfather to the death of my father, and I have owned and occupied the said land since the death of my father in 1929; that the said part of land owned by me, which is part of Vinyard C. Brock's D.L.C., has been owned only by the said Vineyard C. Brock, his son Steward P. Brock, who is my father, and myself since 1854.
