I, Zella M. Burkhart, being first duly sworn depose and say that at the present time I own 87.06 acres of the original D.L.C. of my grandfather, Isaac R. Froman and my grandmother, Eliza Jane Froman, said claim being taken up by my grandparents in the year 1852.

The part that I own at the present time is described as follows: Sec. 22 T. 11 S.R. 3 W, in two parcels, consisting of 77.56 acres, les 7.5 acres that is owned by my sister, Miss Verle E. C. Burkhart, plus 17 acres in the same section, township, and range, consisting of 87.06 acres.

I further swear that I acquired some of this property by virtue of purchasing property from the heirs of Isaac R. Froman and Eliza Jane Froman, and that my mother Lola A. Burkhart, who died March 14, 1955, was the owner of some of this property, and upon her death, I then became an heir to a part of this property which give me in all 87.06 acres, and at the present time, I, Zella M. Burkhart and my sister, Miss Verle E. C. Burkhart, are the sole owners and operators of this farm.

I further state upon oath that I am operating said farm and have continued to operate said farm, continually, since the same has been acquired by me by purchase and heirship.

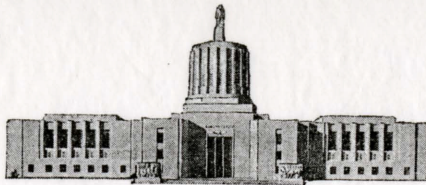
