We further certify that upon the death of William Cochran said property was heired by Robert G. Cochran, and his wife Martha Currin Cochran, they being our grandfather and grandmother. Before the death of Martha Currin Cochran, our grandmother, said property was divided among her three children, namely; Frank W. Cochran, our father; Hugh Cochran and Effie Cochran Smith.

We further certify that after the death of our grandmother, Martha Currin Cochran, our father, Frank W. Cochran bought the remainder of said property from the other heirs, Hugh Cochran and Effie Cochran Smith.

We further state upon oath that upon the death of our father Frank W. Cochran, in 1957, said property was heired by ourselves, Jack B. Cochran and Alice Cochran Shelton, each receiving an undivided one-half interest.

We further certify that we have lived in the past on said farm and we are now operating and managing said farm, and said farm has been in the family possession for more than 100 years.
