I am the grandson of Newton Russell and Susan L. Russell who came to Oregon from Illinois by ox team in 1852 and settled on, and homesteaded, the Newton Russell and Susan L. Russell D.L.C. No. 41 in Sec. 33 & 34 T. 13 S., R. 1 E., and Sec 3 & 4 T. 14 S., R. 1 E., W.M., Linn County, Oregon, consisting of 322 acres.

My father, Oliver H. Russell, was the son of Newton Russell and Susan L. Russell; he was born on said claim April 23, 1858; he was deeded 119 acres of this claim from his parents and he farmed it during his lifetime until 1916. He died February 19, 1933.

I was born January 1st 1894 on the aforesaid D.L.C. No. 41; I leased and farmed my father's property from 1916 to 1927; at which time I purchased my father's interest of 119 acres of the original Donation Land Claim. I still own and operate 19 acres of this 119 acres I purchased from him.

Since 1852 when my grandfather homesteaded the claim, 19 acres of the original Donation Land Claim have been continuously owned and operated by members of the Rüssell family, first by Newton Russell; second by Oliver H. Russell, his son; and third, by myself, Edgar S. Russell, grandson.
