I further swear that at the death of my grandfather and grandmother, said property was heired by A. C. Tindall, Lloyd Timdall and Marion Tindall.

I further certify that my father was Marion Tindall, and at the division of this original homestead, he was awarded approximately 40 acres, and I further certify that my father bought approximately 40 acres.

I further certify that my father, Marion Tindall, resided on this original claim until his death, May 11, 1958, at which time this property was heired by the four daughters of Marion Tindall, which are, Hazel Sims, Venus Standley, Mable Bowman and Pearl Rice.

I further certify that the four heirs of my father, are now operating said land.

I further certify that it is my honest belief that each of said children should be entitled to a certificate from the State Department of Agriculture.

I further certify that we have in the past lived on said farm and are now operating said farm, and said farm has been in the possession of our family for more than 100 years.
