My Greatgrand Father died in June I900 ,My father was farming part of the farm at that, and had been for several years,

I was borned on the west part of ranch in I896, then moved to the east part in Oct I900 after my greatgrand father death, I have lived here ever since.

My Father and Mother Passed away about 4 years ago. Leaving the place to me. The barn was built in I852 or 53. It has hewed timbers put together with wood pegs. These timbers were hew with a foot adz.

I have the deeds from all the heirs to my father, When him and my Mother bought out her brothers & sisters. And Cousins.
