ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In april, 1865, anthony S. Looney + his wife, Mary, purchased 3 40 acres of land from the donation land claimants, Francis + Mary Simpson. He hired chinese labor to clear the oak greet timber from their newly family of six shilling + a large garden for his family of six shilling + a large for chard. On his farm land he raised chifly wheat, outs, + cheat hay He had beef cattle, sheep, & hogs Later he had a fine Jersey dairy herd one of the first in the valley. He had flow made from his wheat at the Boston Howing wills at Shedd, Origon. He had the wool from this sheep made into cloth, and cured & smoked his own sork meat; he drove his own horse-drown transport To southern Oregon where he sold theseproducts to the miners in that region.

The original house burned in 1898 and the house which still stands was built immediately. This house is now occupied by a family of 7 - father

mother o five children.

Fearing for the safety of livestock, the original barn, but together with wooden pegs and square nails, was raged this past wenter + early spring + the usable lumber used in building a large

hay & cattle barn on near by farm land.
My wife, Hazel Thompson Looney, born and reared in albany + moved to the country with me following our marriage in 1916 has continously saved & planted the "Grandma Looney" bean seed. These are white beans & equally good as green string beans or, when dried & shelled on used in our fainty winter beans

This, I would like to add To the Myrule Jerome Looney Century Harm record. Being three fourths (34) mules off of the main country road, Grand Lather, anthony Dewart Looney, purchased a right of way from Jack Trader conver of the land adjacent to the main county road, (now 99E) thus establishing the present road from the I Looney home, to the main county road (now 99E).
