Local century farm 5064 will be recognized

The farm of W.M. (Brownie) Mitchell, Route 2 Box 351, a mile north of Lebanon on Highway 20, will be among those honored at a special program Friday at the Oregon State Fair.

Thirty-seven Oregon families who still operate farms their ancestors settled a century or more ago will receive recognition as century farms in a program on the concert stage starting at 11:30 a.m.

The Mitchell farm, founded by greatgrandfather John Settle in 1847, is one of

six in Linn county to be saluted.

The special program is co-sponsored by the Oregon Department of Agriculture and the Oregon Historical Society's 100th anniversary observance.
