- 1. That I am a grandson of John and Elizabeth Phillips.
- 2. That I am a son of Hannah Phillips who was united in marriage to Samuel H. Barker, my father, February 12, 1896.
- 3. That my grandfather crossed the plains in 1845 to Oregon City, then after working at carpenter work at Saint Paul he settled on a donation land claim of 640 acres, Notification No. 279, Claim Number 50, part of Sections 24 and 25 in Township 6 South of Range 4 West and Claim No. 50, parts of Section 19 and 30 in Township 6 South of Range 3 West. Tha Patent of same being recorded in Book of Deeds, Volume 10, Page 394 on the 10th day of November, 1876.
- 4. That the present 230 acres now owned by Roy E. and Ethel Barker was left to me by my mother, Hannah P. Barker, who died January 3, 1930 and she inherited the same from her parents, John and Elizabeth Phillips. The remainder of the 640 acres were divided among their children. The ownership has been in the continuous possession of John and Elizabeth Phillips or their direct lineal descendants since the year 1847.
