THIS INDENTURE WITNESETH that we ALVAH C. R. SHAW and SARAH E. SHAW his wife, for the consideration of \$6,000.00 to us paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto HARRISON BRUNK the following described premises, to wit:

Six hundred and thirty two acres of land (be the same more or less) the entire land claims of said ALVAH C. R. SHAW and SARAH E. SHAW his wife, (except seven and seventy five hundredths acres which has been deeded heretofore by said ALVAH C. R. SHAW and SARAH E. SHAW his wife to GEORGE T. WALLER) held and acquired under the donation land laws of Oregon and numbered as Claims Notification no. 78 in Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 34, and 35 in T. 7 S, R. 4 W. of the Willamette Meridan of said claim, the west half being designated upon the premises, with their appurtences, unto the said HARRISON BRUNK, his heirs and assigns forever.

And we the said ALVAH C. R. SHAW and SARAH E. SHAW do hereby covenant to and with the said HARRISON BRUNK, his heirs and assigns, that they are free from all incumberances, and that we will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever.
