That I am the daughter of William Savage, Oregon pioneer of 1845, founder of the Dallas City Bank, and of Mary C. Savage, his wife, daughter of James W. and Sarah Woods Lady, Sheridan pioneers of 1852.

That late in the year 1845, my father, the said William Savage, settled on a Donation Land Claim at Willamina Oregon, on the south bank of the Yamhill River in Polk County, State of Oregon, this claim now being shown as Notification No. 5060, claim No. 70, being a part of Section 7 in Township 6 South, Range 6 West and claim No. 39 being part of Section 12 in Township 6 South, Range 7 containing 320.80 acres, the patent to same being recorded in book No. 9 page 120, Deed Records for Polk County, Oregon.

That through heirship and purchase, the title to approximately 254 acres, including the farmstead, now owned by John Cerny and Alta S. Cerny, husband and wife, has been in the continuous ownership and possession of William Savage or his direct linial descendents since the year 1845.

That abstracts of title showing said continuous ownership are available.
