History The Savery clan left Iowa April 1853 and reached the Willamette Valley October of the same year many relatives and neighbors joined the Train composed of fifteen wagons - My Grandfather was a surveyor and helped in the early settlement of the County - Father was Postmaster of Salt Creek during the Hayes Administration.
