History: My frandparents, Hylah and Absalom Smith, came to Oregon in a covered wagon about 1847 and first settled at what is now known as Gerlinger Station. They lived there for awhile and then moved to the farm. They first lived in a log cabin until they could build a house. The census of 1850 shows Absalom Smith, farmer, and lists five affhis family of six children. My father, their youngest child, wasn't born until 1851. My father was Samuel Thurston Smith and the farm has come down to me through him.

I have an old abstract of title and deeds in my possession to prove continuous ownership for over 100 years.
