from a Mrs ^{S.P.} Shellis December 20, 1859.

Mrs Shellis acquired this property
from M. Lisk who had purchased it
from A. S. Hamilton, the 16th of April 1856.

A. S. Hamilton settled on this property
the 27th of Sept, 1850. This was a donation
land claim. It was a half section - 320 acres

At this time 95 acres still belong
to the heirs of J^m Vandewort. However
only one person, ^{myself} has continued to live
on it up to this time.

Parris Powell Winslow at age of 15 wanted to join army 1861 but he was too small + too short, and did not pass the physical. His Cousin Orlando who was tall took the examination under the name of Parris Winslow and passed. Parris then joined the army under his own name but Orlando's description. Parris Powell Winslow was in Co B - 15th Maine and served under General Butler
2nd marriage of Parris Powell was to Addie Vandervoort of Salem Ore. They were married at the Vandervoort farm near community of Brush College, Polk County, Oregon. Addie was born April 10, 1857 and died Dec 31, 1917 on the family farm in Polk Co. Ore.
