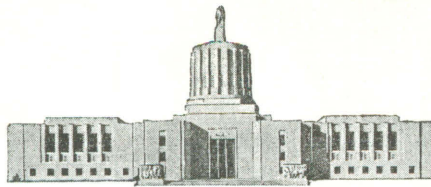

# 90 Yamhill Farm Listed As Century Place

Forty-four more Century farms, including one in the Yamhill area, have come to light this year in the program sponsored by the Oregon Historical society and the state department of agriculture.

L. T. Hutt, Yamhill, was named one of nine additional Century farm owners in Yamhill county.

The new group of Century farm owners, escendants who have stayed continuously with the agricultural pursuits of the farm founder, will be honored in a grand finale at the state fair on September 8.

The oldest farm this year is the Lewis R. Alderman place at Dayton which is 113 years old.
