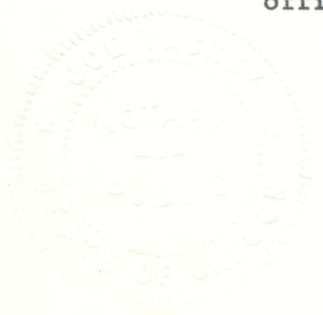

Dear Sir: I am sending in the "Winters" name for the Program as they have owned and worked the place for many years.

This farm is a part of the donation land claim taken up by Phillip and Polly Winters and is Notifycation no. 1840 in T 3 S R 2 W, in Yamhill Co. They came here from Iowa and after stopping at The Dalles for about a month came here and started to make their home.

My Husband's father, Leander Winters helped on the place after the death of his father. Heirs at law were granted the ~~the~~ north half and Polly Winters was granted the south half. Leander Winters later got sixty acres of the north half and bought fifty acres of the south half from his mother. This was divided at the death of Leander Winters, and Ellis A. Winters took the south fifty and Lester Winters the north sixty. The homes are on a piece of the Rodger's donation Land claim bought for the springs. Lester still has his piece and at the death of Ellis, it was given to Mabel L. Winters, wife of Ellis and is now leased to her son Ira A. Winters.
