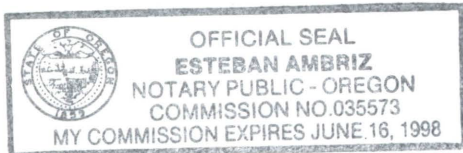

Beginning at the South West corner of the North East quarter of section 26 Township five (5) South of Range One (1) West of Willamette Meridian Marion County, Oregon; Thence East one hundred and fifty (150) rods; thence North eighty (80) rods; thence West one Hundred and forty eight (148) rods thence South Forty two (42) rods and 13 feet; thence West Two (2) Rods; thence South thirty seven (37) rods and 3 1/2 feet to place of beginning containing only that portion of the above described tract of land lying North of the public road, making the public road the south boundary of said land. The whole tract as here described contains fifty eight and eight tenths acres (58.8) more or less all in Marion County, Oregon.

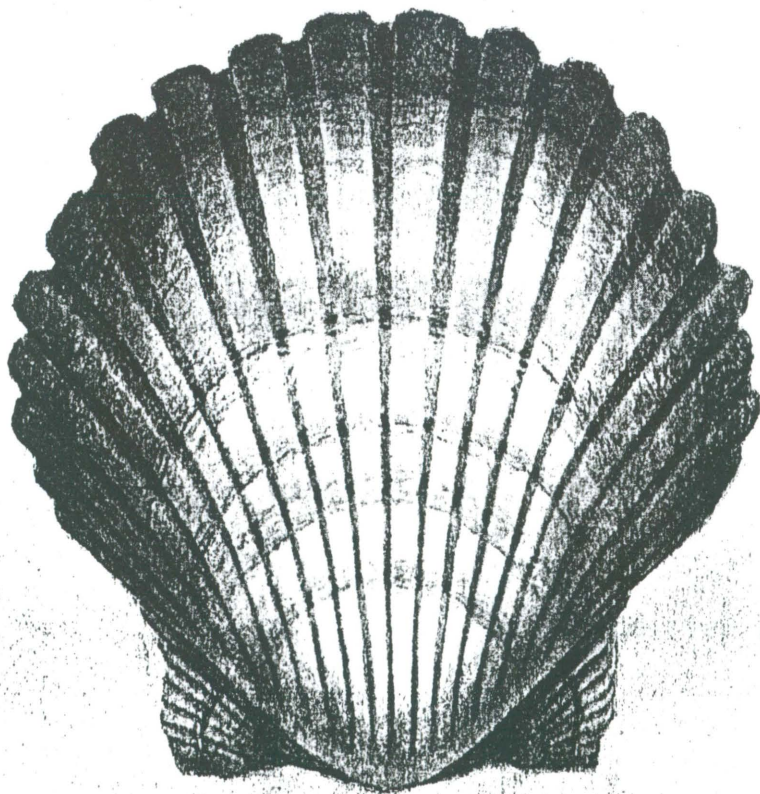
