The property we are applying for Century Farm status was purchased by Harvey and Hannah J. Walker Feb 2, 1889. This inherits down thru the Shields family by Hannah the Mother.

In March 20, 1905 the property was split and 100 acres more or less was sold to George A Shields.

ON May 14, 1920 the property was passed on to George Lewis Shields by will. (This will was too long to copy, but was recorded.) I copied the sheet that mentions the land.

ON June 13, 1949 the property was sold by Geo. Lewis Shields to Donald E. Shields and Helen Southwick. (Brother and sister)

ON April 5, 1956 Helen Southwick ^{her share} sold to Donald E. Shields.

Donald E. Shields has lived on the property for 80 years, moving there when he was 4 years old.

Donald E Shields and his wife

Ina L. Shields started farming in 1932. They have been married for 65 years. Don and Ina farmed until he retired in 1976. Their son Gary Shields farmed the property until Oct of 1988 just 4 months short of 100 years. They then rented the land to Alen McKee, who is a distant relative.

Don and Ina still live on the property. They are both in their 80's. Don has Alzheimers and Ina takes care of him. They both love the land and have worked very hard and are very deserving of the Century Farm recognition.

Due to the fact that it is difficult for Ina to get out, I have researched the deeds and visited with Ina and to the best of our knowledge the above statements are accurate and correct.

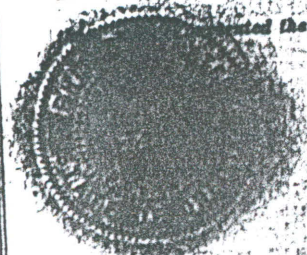

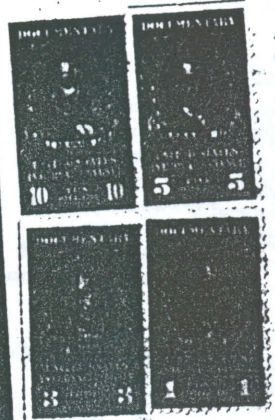
