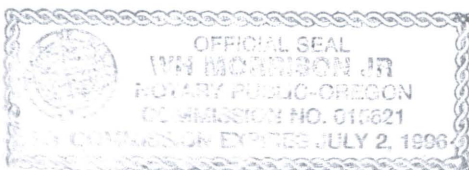

John Henry Lorenzen a free white man, and a
native of *Germany* comes into Court and declares
on oath that it is his BONA FIDE INTENTION TO BECOME A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and to
renounce forever all allegiance to any Foreign Prince, Potentate, State, or Sovereignty, whatever,
and particularly to *King William*
whereof he is a subject.

And the said *John Henry Lorenzen* further states under oath, and
proves, that he came to the United States of America in the year 1872; that at the time he arrived
in this country he was a minor, of the age of *Ten* years. He further states
on oath, and proves to the Court by the oath of *Milton Winley*
a creditable witness, that he has resided in the United States ever since he came here in 1872,
and MORE THAN FIVE YEARS, and within the State of Iowa more than One Year, and that for more
than Three Years past it has been his BONA FIDE intention to become a citizen of the United States
of America. That during the time he has been in the United States he has behaved as a man of good
moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States of America, and
is well disposed to the good order and government of the same.

And thereupon, the said *John Henry Lorenzen* declares on oath
that HE WILL SUPPORT THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and that he doth absolutely
and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any Foreign Prince or Potentate,
State or Sovereignty, whatever, and particularly to *King William*
whereof he was before a subject.

Know All Men By These Presents, that whereas J. D. Cargill of Umatilla County, Oregon, duly made an assignment of all his property, real personal and mixed, including the real property hereinafter described, to J. H. Paley, of said County and State, in trust for the benefit of all the creditors of said J. D. Cargill, which deed of assignment was duly filed for record in the office of the County Clerk of said County on the 22nd day of November, 1893, and recorded in Book "13" at page 174 of the records of deeds of said County, and to which deed reference is hereby made as a part of these conveyances, and whereas said J. H. Paley thereafter on the 7th day of December, 1893, duly accepted said trust and duly qualified as such assignee for the benefit of the creditors of said J. D. Cargill by filing his bond with the said Clerk of said County, and whereas at the October term, 1894, of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, an order was made in the matter of the assignment of said J. D. Cargill, an insolvent debtor, on the 1st day of October, 1894 by the judge of said Court, ordering and directing said J. H. Paley, as such assignee to sell such portions of the real estate to him assigned, and all thereof as he may deem proper and for the best interests of the creditors of said insolvent debtor and of all other parties interested in said estate at private sale without publication of notice of such sale.

Now Therefore I J. H. Paley, as assignee for the benefit of all the creditors of said J. D. Cargill, an insolvent debtor, in

consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to me paid by Henry Lornzen. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant bargain, sell and convey to said Henry Lornzen, his heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described lands, to wit:

All of Section Twenty-two in Township Four North, of Range Thirty-two East of the Willamette Meridian, and also Twenty-two and 7/10 acres in Section Twenty-one in said Township and Range, more particularly described as commencing at the South east corner of the North east quarter of Section Twenty-one Township four North of Range Thirty-two East of the Willamette Meridian, thence running North along the East line of said quarter section 2138 1/2 feet. Thence turning to left at an angle of 92-12' and running westerly 384 1/2 feet, thence turning to the left and running Southwesterly 2165 feet more or less, to a point of the South line of said quarter section 743 feet distant, in a westerly direction from the point of beginning, thence in an easterly direction along the South line of said quarter section 743 feet to the place of beginning, all of said lands being in Multnomah County, and State of Oregon. Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, do have and do hold the same to the said Henry Lornzen and his heirs and assigns forever subject however, to a certain mortgage for \$550.00 upon said lands, which mortgage said Henry Lornzen hereby assumes and agrees to pay as a part of the purchase price of said lands.
