to south west corner of said claim 42 chains 24 links, north 66 chains
18 links to place of beginning and containing two hundred eighty (280)
acres, more or less. -

---that the above described premises are free from any encumbrances,
that it has full right, power and authority to sell the same and that
it will warrant and defend the title unto the said second party his
heirs and assigns and assigns, against the claims of all persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming the same excepting taxes of 1893 and subsequent
years.
