heirs and assigns all the following described real property situated in the County of Washington, and State of Oregon,

to-wit:

*Commencing at the quarter section corner between section 15 and 16 Township six south of range one West Willamette Meridian Thence East on the north boundary of the south half of section 15 fifteen chains and fifty links; thence north three chains and sixty two links to near the middle of the county road leading to Parkersville; Thence N. 15° west thirty three chains and sixty links along the middle of said road to its intersection with the road leading to Mt Gage; thence S. 18° W. twenty one chains and seventy five links to the live spreading section line into north of south halves; Thence east twenty two chains and twenty five links to the beginning of containing 46.04 acres more or less, situated in Marion County of State of Oregon*
