The East half of the North west quarter of Section Number Thirty five in Twp. One, South of Range Three west of the Willamette Meridian, in Washington County, Oregon, containing Eighty acres more or less.

To Have and To Hold the said premises, with their appurtenances unto the said Henry Haase his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Abel Uglow does hereby warrant to and with the said Henry Haase his heirs and assigns, that he is the owner in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims, who claim.
