Dear Mr. Hudemann,

I received your application for the **Century Farm & Ranch Program** last April (please note the new name for the program). The deadline for applications was shifted to July 1 this year, so I have just now completed the initial review of the materials at this time. A total of 13 applications were submitted this year.

Since you submitted your application on a 1998 form, you didn't notice the subtle change in the guidelines adopted this year. We are now requiring both documentation of initial acquisition of the property and the *Statement of Affirmation* signed by a notary public. 
