It gives me great pleasure to inform you that your **Century Farm** application has been approved. Congratulations on receiving this prestigious honor for the <u>Thomas Howard Farm</u>, founded in 1883. A total of 23 farm and ranch owners submitted applications this year and *all* of them met the requirements for Century Farm status. This brings our grand total of Oregon Century Farms to 921 (recognized since 1958 when the program started).

Now that all 1998 applications have been reviewed, we can begin the process of creating the award certificates. These special documents, signed by Gov. Kitzhaber and dignitaries from the Oregon Historical Society, will be available in the late summer or fall.

To recognize your family's accomplishment, it's customary that the certificate be presented in a meaningful way. If you already have an event in mind–such as a special family reunion--please share that information with me so I can have your Century Farm certificate ready by that date (and attend if you wish). The Harney County Historical Society (573-7225) may be interested in hosting a certificate presentation ceremony, perhaps during a regular meeting or event, when you and other family members can officially receive your Century Farm certificate. These are just some of the options available to you.

Dear Mr. Read:

My father, Thomas C. Howard of Drewsey, Oregon, was very pleased that his Century Farm application was approved. However it bothered him to see his property referred to as the "Thomas Howard Farm" in your notification letter of June 5, 1998. Please be aware that this is not the correct name of the property nor of the family business.

Since its inception in 1883, this property has been known as the "Howard Ranch", and it has been used exclusively for ranching operations, not farming operations. We are asking that the historically correct name be used, rather than the one listed in your notification letter.

During the first week in May, I called your office requesting copies of the documents which we had submitted. During that telephone conversation, I specified that the name of the property was the "Howard Ranch". (Enclosed is the photocopy received from your office, with the nota-tion of "Howard Ranch" written on it by someone in your office.)

We request that all Oregon Historical Society's records, communications, award certificates, publications, or documents which refer to our family's property be corrected to reflect the accurate name of "Howard Ranch". This is the name which is historically correct, and the name by which my father would like his property to be known, now as well as in the future.

Thank you for your assistance in correcting this error. It will be very much appreciated!
