

TO ALL TOWNHOM THESE PRESENTS, SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land office at Oregon City, Oregon, whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress, as approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Frederick Benfield has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the northwest quarter of the northead quarter of Section 35 in Township one north of range 4 east of Willamet Meridian in Oregon, containing 40 acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.






