Beatrice Lawhorn, 139 Kerns Court, Napa, California, retired, sister of Roger, owns 40 acres of the original farm.

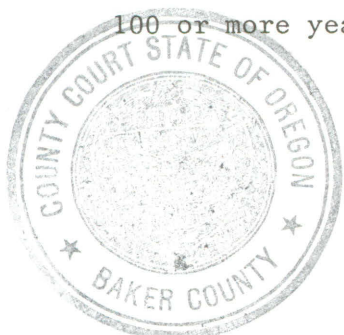
Bill & Bev Loennig, Son and daughter-in-law of Roger, rent and operate all of the original farm.
