ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

My Grandparents and Theirchildren Cleared most of the land by hand. The Old Growth Douglas fir Trees were felled - bored' and borned. The slomps were then grobbed out. Grand father Planted the oldest commercial Italian prine orchard in Clackamos County, He purchased the young Trees from Mr. Lewellyn in Milwackie. My father was born on this form in 1876, and all of his Six Children were also born on this form. I have operated the

form since my fathers death in 1941. My grand father built a prone drier and packed and sold dried prines. Hogs were fortlened, butchered and evred on the form and the cored meal & land as well as the fruit was hoved by wagon to portland, where the main market was the hotels. When the railroad came to Estocada about 1900, The produce including grain was hould to Estavado by Team and wagon and then shipped by rail. We still have the old grain cradle" which was used to Cut the ripened grain. I remember

my fother cutting grain with the credte & binding the bundles by hand with the grain strow. My father and his brother started farming the entire 161. Tacres about 1900. Previous to that they had worked for their father on the form and worked out to get money to buy the form from the Parents and heirs.
