bargain sell and convey to said Christoph Weddler

Three Township Two South Range Three East of the
Wathumette Meridian containing Eighty acres
more or less. Together with the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise

interest (at law and equity therein or thereto
