Blaine, his wife, of the City of Seattle, County of King and Territory of Washington the parties of the first part and William Sturm of the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon the party of the second part, Witnesses, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ten Dollars in Gold Coin of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns the following described tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the County of Clackamas, and State of Oregon, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The First tract, Beginning at the South West corner of Section Eighteen (18) Township Three (3) South of Range Two (2) East of the Willamette meridian; thence East $40\frac{20}{100}$. Thence North 20 chains more or less, to the center of Beaver Creek, thence

The first tract, beginning at the southwest corner of section eighteen (18) Township Three (3) South of Range Two (2) East of the Willamette Meridian; thence East 40 80/100 _____; thence North 20 chains more or less to the center of Beaver Creek; thence Westerly meandering said creek to the west line of said section eighteen (18); thence south on said section line to the place of beginning, and being a fractional part of the Northwest quarter of the donation land claim of Benjamin R. Mael, and containing seventy acres, more or less.

The second tract cornering on the above tract at the South-west corner thereof and known upon the maps and plats of the United States surveys as the fractional Northeast quarter of Section twenty-four (24) Township Three (3) South of Range One (1) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing one hundred and twenty (120) acres, more or less.
