The 1935-1946 period the farm was owned jointly by the heirs of Fred Weatherly. In 1946 Floyd H. Weatherly and Howard R. Weatherly bought out the other heirs and the farm was operated by Howard R. and Floyd V. Weatherly. In 1952 Howard R. Weatherly died and Dorothy C. Weatherly inherited half ownership, but Floyd V. Weatherly assumed full operation of the farm, paying Dorothy C. Weatherly (later married to J. Snow) rent. In 1973 Floyd V. Weatherly bought Floyd H. Weatherly's undivided half. At the present time is jointly owned, with F. V. Weatherly renting D. Snow's half.
