This Indenture WITNESSETH that William Pendleton and Martha Pendleton, his wife, for the consideration of the sum of four thousand five hundred DOLLARS, to me paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Joseph Buchler

the following described premises, to-wit: -
The West half of the North half of section thirty five of Township number five South of Range one West, Williamette Meridian containing one hundred and sixty acres and situated in Marion County and State of Oregon. It is also described as being the West half of the Donation Land Claim of Addison Black and wife and in conveyance in trust, the title from the Donator. To have and to hold, to the above named grantors the following abstract is given viz: Deed of Addison Black and Maria J. Black his wife to S. M. Henderson on the 27th of January A. D. 1865; deed being recorded in Volume seven page 393 Marion Co. Records; from S. M. Henderson and Margaret Henderson his wife to the above named grantors Pendleton and wife on the 2d November 1865, the deed being recorded in Volume 8 page 291 of the same records.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Buchler his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William M. Pendleton does hereby covenant to and with the said Joseph Buchler his heirs and assigns, that he the owner in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever.
