APPLICATION FOR CENTURY FARM RONORS

We are enclosing a photocopy of the deed for the original 160 acres purchased on May 31, 1883 by George F. C. meyer who is norman's great grandfather son-mile son-milaw George FC Meyer sold 15 oares of this 160 oares to Gerhard Goete on December 21, 1893. The remainder of the 160 aares was sold to Gerhard Goete on January 19, 1907. Gerhard Loetze was norman's arandhather. norman's grandfather. Gerhand Loeke bought an additional 4+ acres from Henry FC meyer (norman's granduncle) on august 7, 1909. This punchase was made because a barn was built too close to a property line that prevented space for a barnyard Gerhard Gaetse sold the original 160 sores plus some additional contiguous tracts to John Goetse, Gerhard Goetse, and Fred Sloetse (brothers and sons of Gerhard) on June 11, 1921. They are Father and uncles of normon respectively. Serhard sold his share to John Loetze and Fred Soetze on October 2, 1922. Fred Soetze sold his share to John Goetze on December 30, 1933. Additional arreages for a road night of way were purchased from august Grause by Gerhard Loetze on July 9, 1912. An additional 31.5 acres was purchased by Gerhard Loetze from alwina neukirch on august 24, 1915 as a support for a undow. This land was subsequently sold by John Lotte to albert muchly in the 1960's. albert muchly was a relative of the neukirchs An additional 40 acres was purchased by Gerhard Lotte from adolph neukinch on april 1, 1892. This portion is on integral part of the present property. Norman and Barbara Loetse purchased the present 206 dares from John Loetse on January 1, 1968. It was transferred to their co-trust on march 4, 1976. Technically portions of the farm have been split, but usually to relatives who made partial purchases. The original 160 acres has grown to as much as 236 and is now at 206. We are in possession of all of the deeds, all of which have been recorded in Washington Count

And do covenant with the said hear ge 76 Meyer and has legal representatives, forever, that the said real estate is free from all incumbrances, and that will, and prog heirs, executors and administrators, shall, WARRANT AND DFFEND the same to the said bear ge. 6 Mayer his heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever.
