Dear Mr. and Mrs. Withycombe:

Thank you very much for returning the Century Farm application for the historic James Withycombe farm. We have now had an opportunity to review your application, and find most of the information to be in order. However, there are just two routine items we need to have clarified before the application can be fully approved.

Our first question concerns how the property is currently managed and by whom, and the second item of concern has to do with omitting the notarization on the statement form. Rule 2 requires that the property must have never been rented out, and rule 4 requires the owner/descendent to either live on the farm or to actively manage and direct the farming of the land.

At your suggestion, I contacted your son Mike for further information. However, after our discussion it was still not clear whether the farm is being rented or leased, or how the property is being managed.

Since the deadline for filing the application is over one year away, you can return this information at your convenience, along with the notarized statement form.

Again, our thanks and appreciation for your interest in the Century Farm Program. We look forward to hearing from you.
