Know all Men by these Presents, That James M. Moore and Maria M. Moore his wife do hereby convey to John Schlichting et al. hereby bargain, sell and convey to said John Schlichting and his heirs and assigns forever, the following, to-wit: a part of the Donation Land Claim of G. G. Miller and wife situate in section 27 of Township 2 South of Range 1 West of N. W. 11th Meridian, according to the maps and plats of the United States Survey now on file in the U. S. Land Office at Oregon City, Oregon, said Donation Claim being No. 10449, Certificate No. 3232, the part of said Donation Claim hereby conveyed being all thereof lying on the right or South bank of the Touchstone River reaching to the shore of the stream containing more or less and situate in the County of Washington State of Oregon together with the easements, encumbrances and appurtenances thereto belonging, in anywise appertaining, and also all one estate, right, title and interest at law and in equity therein or thereto, including dower and share of dower, to have and to hold the same to the said John Schlichting and his heirs and assigns forever, And in no manner with the said John Schlichting and his legal representatives from that the said real estate is free from all incumbrances and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John Schlichting and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever except a certain Mortgage to secure payment of \$1000.00 given by J. M. and Maria M. Moore to the Washington Trust Investment Co. duly recorded, the Witness Whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 15th day of January 1878.
