On the 17th of November 1894, the Commissioner of the General Land Office, rendered a decision holding both of these entries for cancellation and both parties have appealed to the Department. In his decision the Commissioner finds from the propeds in his office that both of tese tracts were inclu ded in the Indomnity withdrawal made in 1870, under the act of Congress of July 25, 1866, granting lands to aid in the construction of the Oregon and California Railroad Rxxxxxxy on the 21 of June 1876, approved by the Department and patented to the said @ mpany on the 20 of February 1893, that both of said tracts were subject to such selection at the time the same was made, that both of said en tries were inadvertently and erroneously allowed and ought to be ca celled , and holds that since these tracts have been patented to the Railros o mpany he has nomjurisdiction over them error in the decision of the Commissioner and it is affirmed; and the entries will be can ched.
