ABSTRACT OF TITLE TO

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY SITUATED

Free from incumbrances except mortgage which said grantees are to pay: General Warranty, except as to said mortgage.

Description:

All the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Washington and State of Oregon; and known, designated and described as the South half of the Donation Land Claim of H. N. Colder and wife in Sections 35 and 36, Township 2 North Range 3 West of Willamette Meridian, and containing 320 acres more or less. Reserving however to the said grantors the use, occupancy rents and profits of premises hereinbefore described and hereby conveyed until and including Oct. the first A. D. 1890.

The premises hereinbefore described and hereby conveyed being subject to a mortgage in favor of the School Fund Commissioners of Oregon to secure a note for \$3500.00 due one year after date, which mortgage is recorded on page 616 of Book "P" of Records of Mortgages for Washington County, 36 pages.....
