do hereby grant bargain and sell, and convey to said
John A. McKee, his heirs and assigns forever, the following
described parcel of Real Estate to wit:
All that certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in
the counties of Polk and Yamhill, in the State of Oregon
and which is better known and described as
being a part of Township 6 South Range 4 East of the

Willamette Meridian, Beginning at the South East corner of the claim known as the J. C. Matheney Donation Land claim, as recorded in the Land office of Oregon City Oregon, Thence North $43\frac{50}{100}$ chains to a post, Thence West $40\frac{23}{100}$ chains to a post, Thence South $43\frac{50}{100}$ chains to a post, Thence East $40\frac{23}{100}$ chains to the place of beginning containing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less, situated partly in Polk and partly in Yawhill counties, State of Oregon. Also the following described premises lying and being in Polk county, State of Oregon, in Township 6 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Beginning at the South East corner of said J. C.
