TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the General Land Office, Warrant No. 89,300 for 160 acres, in favor of Sue ar ne che, widow of Istemah ho mah hite, warrior, Captain Oakfuske Yoholas Company Creek, Volunteers,

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon The Southeast quarter of Section Twenty eight, in Township Twenty nine South of Range Twelve West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Roseburg, Oregon, containing One hundred and Sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Sue ar ne che to Calvin M. Warner in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Calvin M. Warner as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of Land above described;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Calvin M. Warner as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Abraham Lincoln President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the City of Washington, the fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty four, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty eighth.
