

The claim of Abraham Jones and his wife Elizabeth Jones of Douglas County, Oregon, Rotification No 222 has been established to a donation of one half section or three hundred and twenty acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and designated according to the official plat of Survey of said land as returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General as the East half of the North West quarter, the Jast half of the South West quarter, the West half of the worth East quarter and the fractional South East quarter (being) (the North East quarter of the South East quarter and Lots two and three) of Section fifteen in Township Twenty seven South of Range six West in the District of lands subject to sale at Roseburg. Oregon. containing three hundred and twenty three acres and forty six hundredths of an acres.



... Do give and grant unto said Abraham Jones and to his heirs the North half and unto his wife the said Elizabeth Jones and to her heirs the South half of the tract of land above described. . . .

Abraham and Elizabeth Jones homesteaded the property.

He took over management of the property in 1921. He was the 10th child of Arthur and Henrietta Cloake.

On his death in 1989, I (Marion J. Scheleen) inherited the property—it is approximately 40 acres now.

My son, Donald K. Scheleen, is managing the property

now.

He operated a hotel in Roseburg. They migrated to Boone County, Indiana between 1833-34. Jacob was a pioneer in Ohio, Indiana, and Oregon. To Oregon in 1852.
