Regards; Balin Ranch history and operation.

The Balin family came from Kansas in the early 1900's. The Klamath Bureau of Reclamation irrigation project was completed in 1906 and soon after that, the Balin's started farming the land that is now part of the Balin Farm and Ranch operation.

In April 1910 about 100 acres of that land was deeded to Mary Balin and has been in continuous operation by the Balin family for over the past 100 years. Otto Balin, was the son of Mary Balin and his wife, Ethel Balin, where the cornerstones in developing the Balin Ranch as we know it today. In the field of agriculture, Otto Balin was known to be one of the hardest working individuals in the Klamath Basin.

Harold Balin, their son, was the next generation in line to keep the Balin family ranch together. Scott Balin, the son of Harold Balin, both went Oregon State College and graduated in the field of agriculture and are presently operating the family ranch. Scott has two sons Bryce and Trent, and also a daughter Elise. Bryce is taking agriculture in college, so hopefully the family ranch will continue into the next generation.

The operation has expanded thru the years to about 800 acres of irrigated crop land and around 900 acres of irrigated pasture land located about 45 miles from the home farm. In the 1930's into the early 1950's, our cattle were driven to our summer pasture in Langell Valley, a cattle drive that would take three to four days, with over night along the way. Today we use trucks and the cattle are moved in a fraction of the time.

All the land has water rights and is deeded to the Balin Farm Trust, DBA as the Balin Ranches. The Balin Ranch also leases around 270 acres of crop land and 880 acres of pasture land.

The farm is in the business of raising organic grass fed beef, hay for our livestock and dairy hay. The farm also raises commercial and some organic potatoes. We are one of the larger producers of USDA certified organic grass fed beef in the State of Oregon and most of our beef is sold thru Whole Foods Grocery Stores. The ranch sells some beef under its own label of, "Cascade Organic Beef". Copy of label enclosed. We also sell some organic certified hay to organic dairies.

The farm has always tried to stay efficient and maintain a economic farm base while raising food and fiber for our country. Two of our main concerns is water and energy. The farm has come from the old days of gravity irrigation to the more efficient water saving sprinkler systems. Thru reinvesting, we now have three pivot irrigation systems on the farm.

A 100 KW Electric Solar Power plant was just completed in August of 2011 and consists of eight solar tracking stations. The plant will supply most of the power for two 75 hp sprinkler pumps and a 240 acre pivot system.

Today I feel the Balin Ranch is a living memorial to the hard work that Balin Family has made in the past and with the same determination, hopefully it will survive another 100 years of producing food and fiber for our country.
